

FloorWizard Setup Instructions for Java Version 7 Update 60


Click the **“Install Java”** button from the FloorSoft website, then click the **“Run”** button shown below and follow the on screen prompts to install Java version 7 update 60.



After installing Java 7 update 60 on your computer using the **“Install Java”** button from the FloorSoft website, you will be redirected to the Java website to uninstall older versions of Java.

Java developers recommend that all older versions be removed, to ensure that your computer is up to date with all recent security and performance enhancements. To do this, follow the on screen commands then close your browser when complete.

Some other Java applications may be dependent on an older version of Java, and may not run if you uninstall these older versions. If you are unsure, leave the older versions in place and simply close your browser.

Verify Java and Find Out-of-Date Versions

Check to ensure that you have the recommended version of Java installed on your Windows computer and identify any versions that are out of date and should be uninstalled.

By clicking Agree and Continue, you acknowledge that you have read and accepted the [license terms](#) for the verify and find old versions feature.

After clicking the button, a security prompt may appear. Click **Run** to allow the application to continue.

If you recently completed your Java software installation, you may need to **restart your browser** (close all browser windows and re-open) before verifying your Java version.

After installing Java 7 update 60 on your computer, you will need to adjust the security settings before it is compliant with FloorWizard. See below:

- Click **Start**. In the Start Search box, type command.

A list of matches will appear. Right-click Command Prompt in the Programs list.

Click **Run as administrator**

- Launch command prompt as administrator

To open the Java Control Panel, in the Command Prompt window type:

64 Bit System =

"c:\Program Files (x86)\Java\jre7\bin\javacpl.exe"

32 Bit System =

"c:\Program Files\Java\jre7\bin\javacpl.exe"


- Press the **Enter** key.
- Close the Command Prompt

- Click **Control Panel** → **Programs** → **Programs and Features** → **Java (32 bit) Icon**


You should see the following window on your screen:

- Click the **Security** tab to continue:



You should see the following panel:


- Set the security level to **Medium** using the slider bar
- Next, Click the **Apply** button



- Now, we need to ensure that Java's automatic update function is disabled. Click the **update** tab to continue.


You should see the panel shown below:

- Ensure the **Check for Updates Automatically** checkbox is not checked as shown below.
- Click the **OK button** to close the Java Control Panel.


- Click the **“Advanced”** tab
- Now, scroll down to the bottom of the window, and find the **“Miscellaneous”** category. Click the checkbox next to **“Place Java icon in system tray”**
- Click the **“OK”** button

- Next, open **Internet Explorer**. In the upper right hand corner of the browser, click the **“Tools”** icon that looks like a sprocket. Then, select **Internet Options**.
- Click the **Security** tab.
- Using the slider bar, set the security level to **“Medium”**
- Click **“OK,”** then click **“Apply”**

Next, open Internet Explorer, and go to the FloorWizard Logon page. Click the **“Run Updates”** button as shown below. Follow the on screen commands to update the Bluetooth laser interface.




All users see next page...

- **** All Users Follow These Steps ****
- Now, Login to FloorWizard and click the **Check In / Out** button.
- On the **Checkout** tab, click the **Checkout** button.
- When the system has downloaded the latest updates, you should logout and close all Internet Explorer browsers.
- Next, Open **Remote FloorWizard**. While the Applet is loading, you should see the following Java dialog box on your screen:

- Ensure this box is checked !!!

- Click the **Run** button.
