FloorWizard Setup Instructions for Java Version 7 Update 60

Click the **"Install Java"** button from the FloorSoft website, then click the **"Run"** button shown below and follow the on screen prompts to install Java version 7 update 60.



After installing Java 7 update 60 on your computer using the "**Install Java**" button from the FloorSoft website, you will be redirected to the Java website to uninstall older versions of Java.

Java developers recommend that all older versions be removed, to ensure that your computer is up to date with all recent security and performance enhancements. To do this, follow the on screen commands then close your browser when complete.

Some other Java applications may be dependent on an older version of Java, and may not run if you uninstall these older versions. If you are unsure, leave the older versions in place and simply close your browser.
